Situation

Situation

Part 1: Individual long turn (4-6 minutes)

You have been asked to give a talk about your personal travel preferences. In your talk you should

- describe your best holiday experience
- inform about your favourite type of holiday (Input 1)
- highlight the benefits of travelling.

After your talk, a representative of *TeenTravel*, an online travel agency for young people, engages you in a conversation. In your conversation you should include the following:

- your favourite destinations for a holiday
- the importance of travelling in your life
- pros and cons of going on holiday with your parents or with friends (Input 2).



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
